
## UNIT 2: THE KEYBOARD




There are black keys and white keys on the keyboard.

There are groups of two black keys. . .








...and there are groups of three black keys.








# GRANDMA'S HOUSE

To help you remember the names of the keys, think of the three black keys as "Grandma's House." (Adapted from a story by Allyson Reed.)




Here they are all together on the keyboard.

Think of the two black keys as Grandma's Yard.




Here they are all together on the keyboard.






# GRANDMA'S YARD, CONT.


Sometimes Grandma's  $oldsymbol{D}$  og is in her back yard, by the  $oldsymbol{B}$  ack door.


