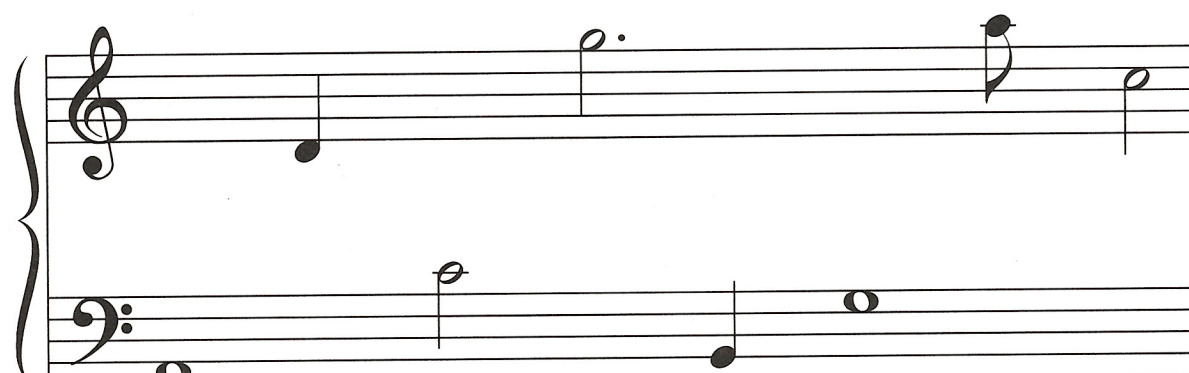
LETTER NAMES OF NOTES
