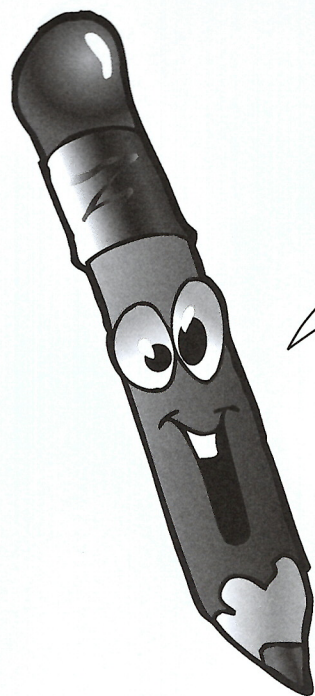


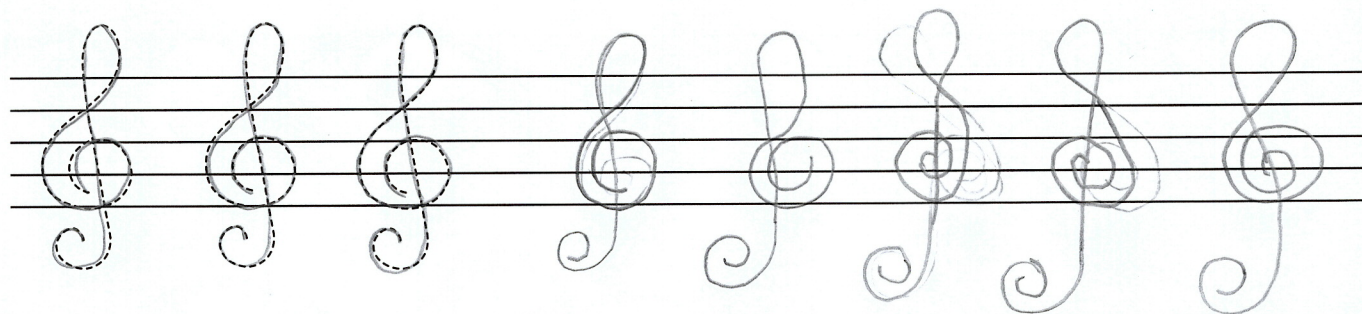
TREBLE CLEF



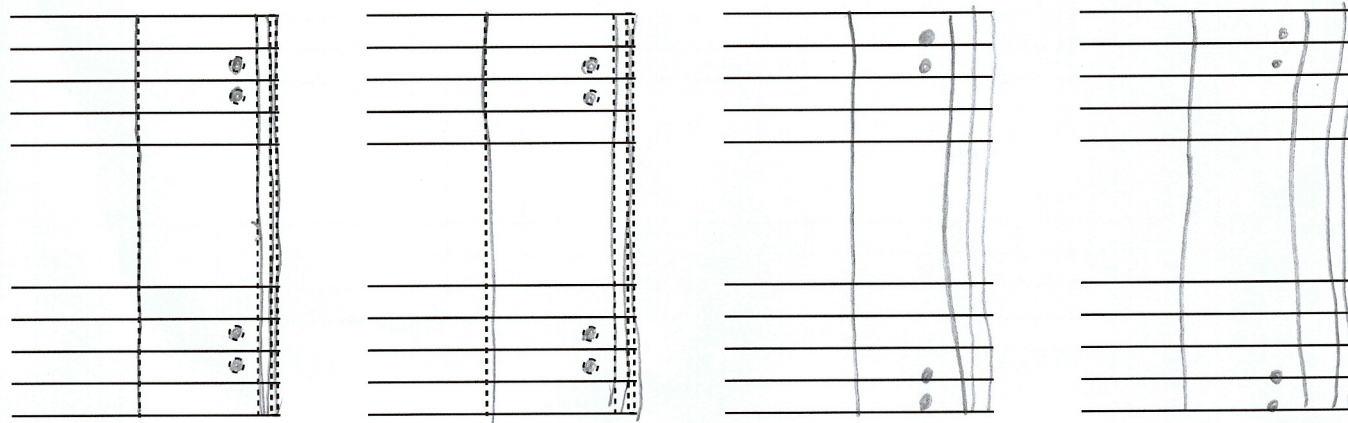
Practice drawing
the treble clef.
Begin at the black dot.

1. Begin here. →
2. Draw the line up and around. →
3. Notice that the lines cross here, at the fourth line... →
4. ... and the treble clef sits on the bottom line. →
5. Finish drawing the treble clef by wrapping around the second line. →

1. Trace these treble clef signs then draw five more.



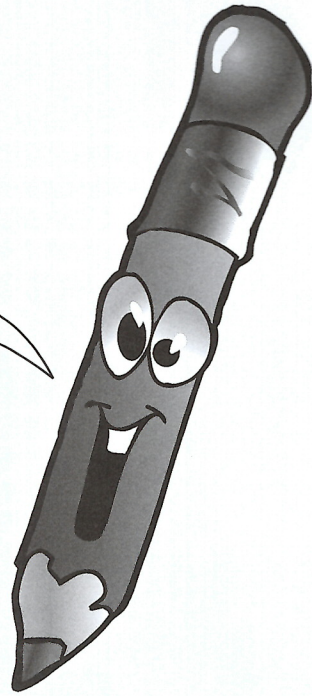
2. Trace these barlines, double bars, and repeat signs, then draw two more.





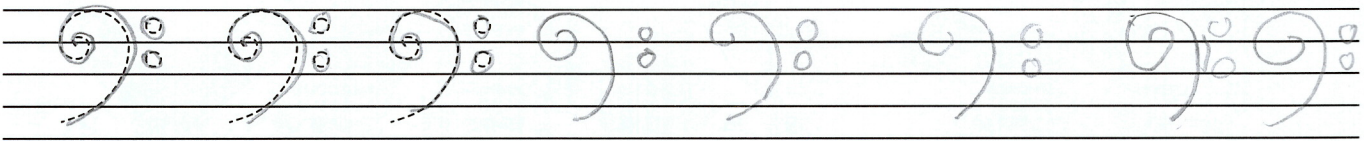
BASS CLEF

Practice drawing
the bass clef.
Begin at the black dot.

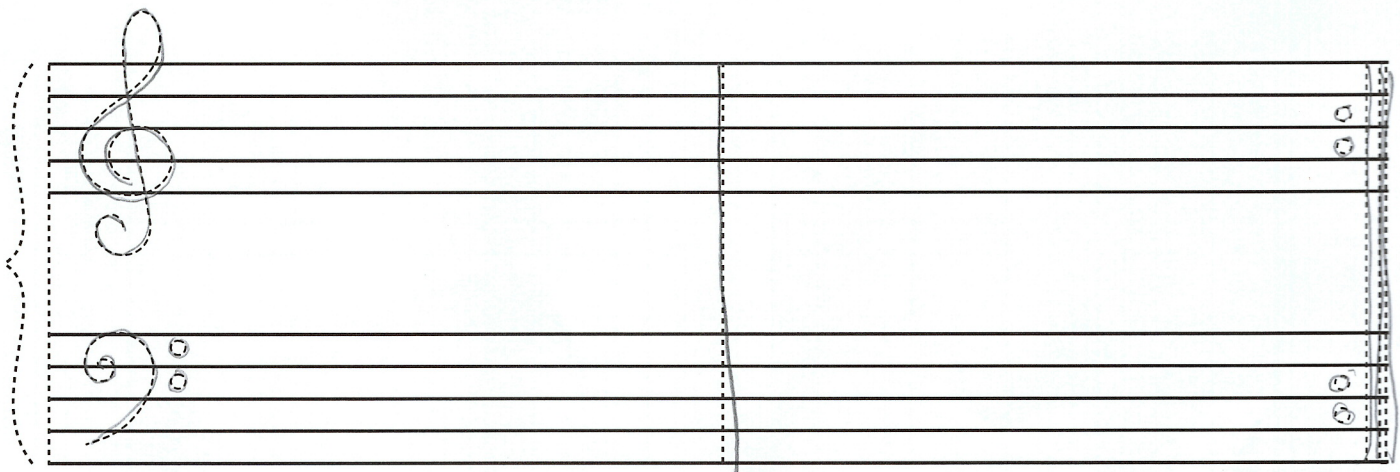


2. Draw the line up and around.
1. Begin here.
3. Notice that the bass clef touches this line.
4. End in the bottom space.
5. Place the dots on either side of this line.

1. Trace these bass clef signs then draw five more.



2. Trace the parts of the grand staff and the repeat sign.

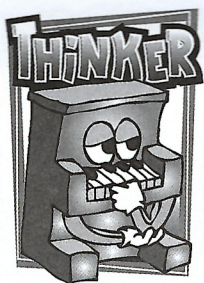


THE GRAND STAFF
