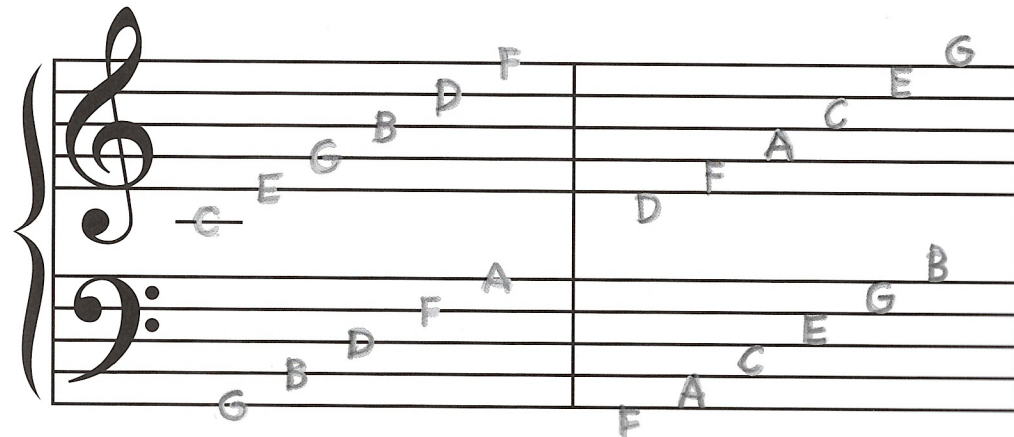
Bastien Music Flashcards
